multi-contract projects funded through the Drinking Water Systems Improvement Revolving Load Fund administered by MDEQ. These projects were undertaken to eliminate low pressure areas, eliminate sections of asbestos cement piping, and to provide additional storage capacity. The combined cost of these projects was \$2.7 Million and included the installation of 62,000 feet of water mains, three service pump replacements, 187 service connections and the installation of five new elevated water storage tanks ranging in capacity from 100,000 to 300,000 gallons.
